Upon Arrival: Coaches & cars should park in the dedicated parking area situated at the back of Charter Hall.

Parking tickets Parking for the contest is FREE, however anyone parking in the car park will need to get there parking ticket validated at guard reception or at the machine within the arena during the day (announcements will be made to remind our audience of this.)
We have been assured that the barrier to the back of the building will be lifted at the end of the contest to ease congestion.

Unit Reception: All units should book in at reception, this will open at 10:30 and is located in the main entrance at the centre box office desk. You should hand in your MP3 player and you will be advised of any time changes here.

DVD Facility: We have a facility on site to record your performance onto DVD, the charge will be £5 per competing unit and is payable at Unit reception. Blank DVD's will be provided. In addition a photo pass can be obtained at the extra charge of £2 when brought in conjunction with our DVD.

Wristbands: You will be issued with the relevant number of wrist bands for your registered members and staff according to the number advised to us by WGUK. Please ensure that the numbers marching are correct as this will be checked at pre-entry.

Please ensure that your staff and members have their wristbands visible at all times – a strict **no wristband / no entry** rule will be in force.

Main stand: Spectator seating can be accessed through the main entrance – following the signs.

All middle tiered seating will be for paying spectators ONLY. Please ask your members and staff to sit in the allocated tiered seating area situated to the far left and far right of the arena.

Scenery: All equipment, floors and props can be unloaded at the scenery storage area located at the back of building at the following times:

Cadets/juniors: 10:30

Please note we have very limited space available for storage this year, therefore there will be no storage available for very large scenery.

All equipment **MUST** be cleared from the scenery area immediately after your performance ends as there is no where to store it.

Changing: There is no allocated changing area.

Sound checks: Audio CD and MP3 playback facilities are available.
Sound check will be at 11:15 – 11:45 and if necessary during the break between the junior and A guards.
Please make sure you have a back up copy on audio CD.

Catering: A Bar and restaurant is situated on the first floor.

Warm up: **Guard warm up** is situated in the squash courts – accessible from the front of the building only - following the signs (there is no access to warm up from back of the building)

Percussion warm up will be inside the main hall at the allocated time.
If units wish to rehearse they can not play outside the venue, however the Castle Park is only 5 minutes away in a car. Please be aware that units can not rehearse inside the building.

All - Please make your own way to the warm up area at the stipulated time on the timetable, at the end of warm up a steward will escort you to pre-entry area for a wrist band check. Please move out of the warm area immediately upon request.

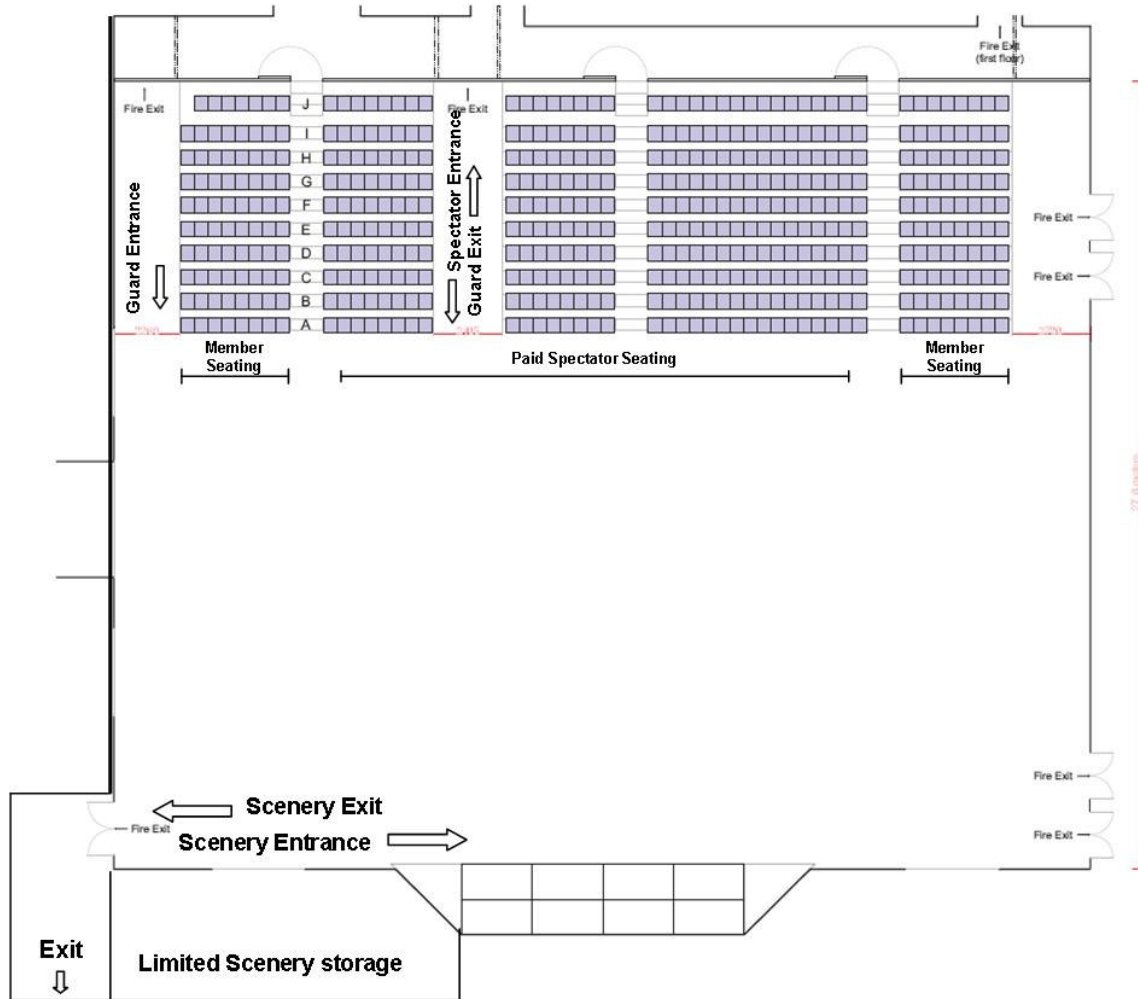

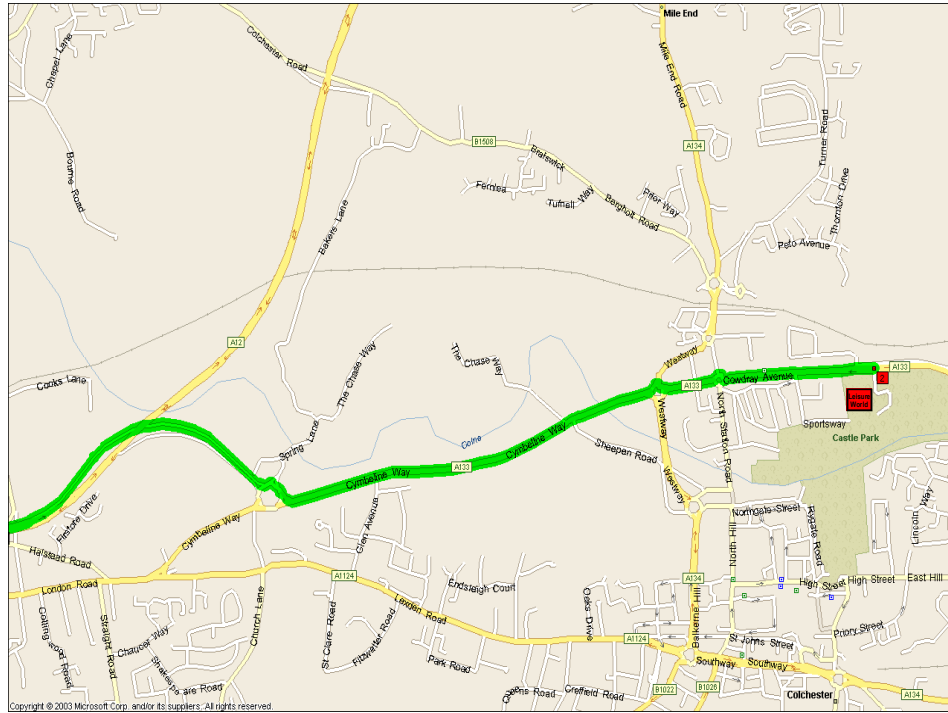
Charter Hall Seating Plan
